## Septic Field Information

We are getting through the rainy season but thought these tips might help with our hard working Septic Fields. Check out the info below and see if you are up to speed!!

### Do's & Don'ts



- \* **Do** use environmentally friendly liquid detergents for washing machines and dishwashers.
- \* **Don't** use liquid fabric softener.
- \* **Do** use dryer sheets.
- \* **Don't** pour grease into drains. Grease won't break down and will solidify in your system.
- \* **Do** dispose of it in the garbage as solid waste.
- \* **Don't** use garbage disposals as a trash can. Garbage disposals are to be used for table food scraps. (ex: No corn husks, paper, meat bones)
- \* **Don't** wait until the weekend to do the whole weeks' worth of laundry.
- \* **Do** spread out the laundry over the course of the week, so you don't over work your drain field.
- \* **Do** use bleach in moderation. Large amounts of chlorine kills the good bacteria needed to maintain a healthy septic system.
- \* **Don't** flush anything that is not septic safe toilet paper or waste down the toilet.  
(ex: feminine products and baby wipes)
- \* **Do** remember, if it's toxic to you... it is also toxic to the septic system.

### Don't Flush It

Homeowners wanting to take good care of their septic systems should make note of the following items that should never be flushed down the drain or toilet. These items can overtax or destroy the biological digestion taking place within the system or clog pumps and pipes.

Take care not to flush the following:

- hair combings, coffee grounds, dental floss, disposable diapers, or kitty litter,
  - sanitary napkins, tampons, cigarette butts, or condoms,
- gauze bandages, fat, grease, or oil, paper towels,  
and **NEVER** flush chemicals that could contaminate surface and groundwater, such as:
- paints, varnishes, thinners, waste oils, photographic solutions, or pesticides.

**June 20, 2013 HAPA Board Meeting Time: 6:45 PM Location: The Beacon Café**

Tom Martin –President meeting started 6:48pm

Ted Kelso- Secretary was absent no minutes submitted for approval from May meeting- Mary Reddick is taking minutes for this meeting.

Tom- reported that 1200 feet of taxiways were repaired and a cement pad was installed at the south entrance - Mike Olson chaired this project and Tom would like to thank everyone who pitched in and helped Mike Olson with this undertaking. The Brunson's resurfaced 1/3 of the ramp around the fueling area.

Tom- is working with a plumber to catch up on the septic field's general maintenance. A copy of the DO's & DON'T's will be republished in the next Flapping's (when the tanks are being pumped there is A LOT of personal hygiene items that should not be in put into the system)

Mike- Treasurer the May financials were given to the Board. Roy Geer made a motion to accept 2nd by Gene DuBullet- motion passed. Website (T67.org) is being used more & more by members- Contributions for Flapping's articles/stories and pictures are always welcome, please submit to the editors. The mailboxes will stay where they are presently located. A five year agreement has been signed. (Please remember that hangar is used as a residence and refrain from using your horn as you wait to get your mail.)

Roy – Vice President - South gate is still broken. The bottom rail failed and the wheel is broken - the gate will remain open until repairs are complete.

Carol Moran –PMG violations are being sent to members: tall grass and a lot of trailer parking outside of hangars. Tom has been working diligently with members to get past due assessments paid, we are at the lowest amount due to HAPA in several years.

### **Unfinished business-**

Steve Carter- Gave the board more questions and wants to know the BOD status of his concerns of the new hangar that will have a non-aviation commercial business being constructed on taxiway 3. Tom stated the board is still gathering information and trying to make an accurate decision. The HAPA attorney has been

notified - volumes of information has been received from Steve Carter and is being investigated by the board before making a decision. Tom knows some people will like the Board's decision and others won't- Several members- Harry Rose, John Efinger, Larry Henson, Phillip Leroux, Bryan Martin, Harvey Ackermann and Carol Morris – all voiced opinions on allowing commercial non-aviation and hazardous material businesses at Hicks airport. The time frame for BOD decision was discussed and agreed it would take several months. Mike Bruno- Wanted to thank the Board for stepping up- he has concerns regarding the 5th amendment and the covenants not being followed. After discussion Mike Reddick will bring a list of commercial non-aviation businesses to the next meeting and let the members discuss how enforcement should be done. Bryan Martin- also spoke about taxiway repair and that for 20 years no maintenance or upkeep was done at Hicks and the catch-up now is a big task. He feels that 100' of 6" cement should be laid every time repairs/up-keep is done at Hicks. Tom's vision for the future is to see cement on all taxiways John Efinger wanted to know the status of a committee that were re-writing the CCR's. He was informed that the committee did not complete the task.

### **New Business-**

The Fall HAPA Social will be on Saturday September 14. It will be a barbeque, HAPA will buy the meat (the social committee is looking for volunteers to cook it) Alan Sanderson would like to have a Wings program as part of the Social and will check on the details. Check T67.org for more details.

Next BOD meeting will be held on Thursday July 11th 6:30pm at the Beacon Café.

Motion to adjourn at 7:45 by Roy, second by Gene. Motion passed.

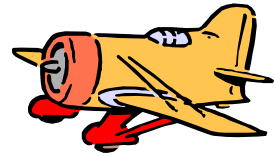
