It appears that the long hot summer may be behind us. Our first dose of fall rains have come and gone and we can only cope with the small flood, given our individual topography.

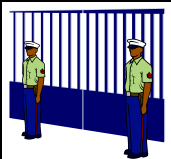
On the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September we had our September Board of Director's meeting. Topics discussed centered around canine violations from a health and safety standpoint. Several of our members have been approached by dogs without leashes and no where near their masters. One dog has been shot. One lady sighted a north end hangar where several dogs were left for days with resulting feces and injuries to the dogs when they became "hung up." I have asked our management service to look into this matter as it impacts the health and safety of our airport. The allegations, if accurate, make out a case of animal cruelty which could be prosecuted. I can not overstate the need to keep dogs on leashes as dogs don't understand airplanes and most pilots aren't looking for loose dogs on airports.

Other matters that are being looked into include a possible listing of businesses on the airport on an advertisement basis near the south gate. This would be operated by H.A.P.A. and be available to those commercial establishments that wanted the service. Good idea or bad idea?

There was also conversation where several members desired a uniformity or "upgrade" as to the north end border fence, gates, etc. If you'll look at the north end of our airport and compare it to our south end, one would hardly recognize it as being the same airport. Hopefully, those individuals with property that border the county road easement would want to get together concerning a common fence from a materials and height standpoint. I believe the Board of Director's would then finance some replacement fence, gates, etc. and the north end could take on a new look. Anyone that would be willing to chair this undertaking would certainly be welcome.

In December we will have elections of three Board members. Although this is still a couple of months away, I would welcome the names of anyone interested along with their biography in advance. The biographies will be Published in Flappings' November issue, so please have them submitted to the Editor by October 15.

Lastly, several delinquent accounts have been sent to the HAPA attorney for collection or foreclosure. Please make sure your account is not one of those being pursued.
